- be a local government elector for the Community of Lympsham
- have, during the whole of the previous 12 months, occupied land or other property in the community, either as owner or tenant
- have, during the whole of the previous 12 months, had your principal or only place of work in the community
- have resided in the community during the whole of the previous 12 months

The Parish Council normally meets on the third Monday of the month at 7.30pm (except August).
