- Neighbourhood Watch: Clerk writing letter to Commissioner; latest SID findings received.

- Highways: Some temporary road signs removed; Cllr. Tuttiett repeated concerns for the historic fingerpost: Clerk to contact
  SDC Conservation Officer; continued concern expressed re road subsidence despite Highways 'reassurance'; Clerk thanked
  for representing PC at Development Committee meeting re Solar Farm application disappointment expressed that despite
  some support for the PC's concerns re traffic management plan, Highways' early approval appeared to overrule safety issues.
- Play Area inc. inspection report: Order confirmed with Wickstead re replacement swing predominately wooden structure (probably installed January); Clerk to apply to Nuttall Trust for next part of 'rolling programme' & Cllr. Rosser would be seeing Wickstead representative re funding forms – may need to have community events to raise funds.
